SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION

- Enrollment forms must be completed online PRIOR to registration for your camp locations and sessions. Visit ymcawichita.org/camp to fill out enrollment forms.
- Weekly fees must be paid in advance, on Monday, one full week prior to camp. Children with unpaid or past due accounts will not be allowed to attend camp.
- A one-time \$15 enrollment fee and \$20 weekly deposit secures your space and are required at registration (Frontier Horse Camp deposit is \$70). Deposits are deducted from your weekly fee. Deposits are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- To cancel a registration and avoid charges, contact Child Care Accounts at 316.776.8842 or childcare@ymcawichita.org prior to registration closing for the select week. Refunds will NOT be given after registration closes. Full fees will be due regardless of attendance.

INTEREST CENTERS

IGNITE!

IGNITE is what we call our morning meetings and announcements held daily, it is a great celebration of friendship and togetherness to kick off the day!

D.E.A.R.

Drop Everything And Read is a scheduled time each day where kids can relax and read, either individually or in small groups! Bring your favorite book or read one of ours.

Branch Adventure Camps - Each week youth will participate in STEM, arts and crafts, theme-related games, physical activities, climbing wall (where available), swimming, character development and team-building fun.

Farha Sports Camps - Morning activities M-TH are led by local college coaches and athletes. Afternoons are primarily scrimmages to practice skills learned in the morning, and includes swimming at the branch. Andover travels to South on Fridays for some friendly competition.

Morning CLUBS (at Hyde) - A variety of counselor-led fun where kids choose their activity, which include team sports, chess club, arts and crafts and other theme-related games.

CAMPERS All children welcome, regardless of Greater Wichita YMCA membership. Children served by the Kansas Department of Children and Families accepted at each of our camp locations.


