

SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION

- Enrollment forms must be completed online PRIOR to registration for your camp locations and sessions. Visit ymcawichita.org/camp to fill out enrollment forms.
- Weekly fees must be paid in advance, on Monday, one full week prior to camp. Children with unpaid or past due accounts will not be allowed to attend camp.
- A one-time \$15 enrollment fee and \$20 weekly deposit secures your space and are required at registration (Frontier Horse Camp deposit is \$70). Deposits are deducted from your weekly fee. Fees are non-refundable. Weekly deposits can be transferred to another week of camp on or before May 1st, after this date these fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- To cancel a registration and avoid charges, contact Child Care Accounts at 316.776.8842 or childcare@ymcawichita.org prior to registration closing for the select week (Monday prior). Refunds will NOT be given after registration closes. Fees are due in full regardless of attendance.
