KEY ACADEMY OVERVIEW

When school is out, you can trust the Y to provide an engaging experience for children in their own school. The Greater Wichita YMCA's KEY Academy allows children to deepen understanding of and relationships with their schoolmates through active play and collaboration on fun, engaging projects. The inclusion of a healthy snack morning and afternoon, and support for homework and learning ensures a well-round program.

KEY Academy is owned and operated by the Greater Wichita YMCA. The KEY Academy program is licensed by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) and open to children, regardless of YMCA membership status.

KEY Academy programs serve elementary youth aged 5 to 12 in over a dozen school sites across six local school districts. AM sessions, where available, begin at 6:30AM and end with staff dismissal of kids at the start of the school day. Afternoon sessions begin when students arrive after school is dismissed and close at 6:00PM.

CONTENT AND DAILY ACTIVITIES

When participating in Greater Wichita YMCA KEY Academy programs, your child will think they are simply having fun, but you'll have the peace of mind knowing they are not only expanding their minds and social skills but developing lifelong healthy habits. Enrolled Kindergartners through students, age 12, will benefit from:

PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

- Youth enrolled in our AM sessions participate in 20–30 minutes of morning exercise from yoga to calisthenics they are moving, getting the body and mind active for a great start to the day. When they head to class they are energized and ready to learn.
- Afternoon sessions include 30–45 minutes of active play daily. Student participates in planned physical games and activities that teach team work and good sportsmanship. Weather permitting children spend time outdoors daily.

HEALTHY EATING

- Healthy snacks are offered in the morning and afternoon session. Our afternoon program sites are supported by the Child and Adult Care Food Program. Families should ensure children have eaten breakfast prior to arrival as outside food is not permitted in the program.

Y-CHATS

- Daily opportunities for youth and adults to connect and “chat” are skillfully designed and planned to help kids develop self-awareness, self-management, social-awareness, relationship skills, and responsible decision-making.
- Chats are scheduled in advance. Parents are encouraged to track themes and

monthly calendars for insights on area of focus and monthly questions so they can continue the conversation at home.

HOMEWORK SUPPORT

- KEY Academy staff set aside 30 minutes, each Monday–Thursday afternoon for quiet activities and to support those with homework and assignment completion.
- Study time reinforces positive learning habits and can allow more family time each evening.

AFTERNOON ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

- Themes will feature our NEW Skillastics curriculum! Themes vary from general fitness, sports, character development, nutrition and academic integration. Skillastics makes physical activity fun and educational for kids of all ages and is a perfect match for our YMCA priorities of youth development, healthy lifestyles and social responsibilities. Activity schedules will vary by location.

BUILDING COMMUNITY

- Considered in every activity and interaction within KEY Academy programs, day-to-day interactions and team building activities with peers and Y staff focus on growing positive relationships and skills to avoid, minimize the frequency of-, and more-quickly resolve conflict.

LOG-IN

- Using your email and password log in to your YMCA account and select the child you wish to enroll from the drop down list.
- First Time User? No problem, simply follow the online instruction to set up an account and you will be ready in no time.
- Having trouble? Can't see your child in the drop down or forgot the email linked to your account? Call or visit any YMCA location for assistance or reach out to our Child Care Account team at childcare@ymcawichita.org for assistance.

COMPLETE ENROLLMENT INFORMATION (KDHE FORMS)

- Once you have logged in and selected the child you are ready to fill out the KDHE forms. Follow the link and prompts – make sure they are complete so registration is not delayed!
- We do not provide paper forms – all KDHE forms must be completed on-line.
- On-line forms are required BEFORE you can register your child for a location/ session and confirm space. (Registration closes on Monday's at 10 PM, you must complete enrollment AND registration by this time

one FULL week before your wish to begin services.)

- This information is collected annually for the KEY academy sites. Sorry, your prior year or summer camp forms are not valid. These forms ARE valid for the full school year for any KEY Location, School Day Out or Break Club!!

REGISTER AND SECURE A SPACE!

- Forms alone do not secure a space for your student.
- Registration at a YMCA Branch is required. Any of our 11 branch locations can assist you in selecting your school, session and pay registration fees.
- Registration forms can be found on-line, at any branch and in most of our school locations!
- Once you have turned in your registration form, finalized the location and session with the membership team and paid your registration fee, your space is secured!

WEEKLY FEES

- Fees are due one FULL week in advance – sign up for credit card or bank draft at registration!
- Fees are due regardless of attendance
- Written notice in advance is required to cancel registration and stop billing.
- Make sure to review carefully the payment and billing policies found on the web in the Parent Information and Policy pages. (Printed copies are available at all KEY locations and YMCA membership desks.)

EXPERIENCED

All KEY Academy Staff:

- Our established child care providers - averaging 4+ years of relevant experience.
- Meet-or-exceed the minimum KDHE requirements for education and experience.

WELL-TRAINED

The Greater Wichita YMCA provides KEY Academy Staff with:

- 16+ annual hours of training and in-service development;
- Training in Pediatric CPR and AED usage and First Aid;
- Supervision and behavior management training;
- Tools for recognizing, preventing, and reporting child illness and child abuse;
- All YMCA employees have a Comprehensive Background Checks to ensure the safety of all program participants;
- Kansas Bureau of Investigation and Federal Bureau of Investigation Name and Fingerprint Database Checks are conducted by KDHE.

ROLE MODELS

KEY Academy Staff are positive, caring adults who:

- Appropriately engage, challenge, and nurture students to challenge every child's potential.
- Exemplify and personify our YMCA Core Values (Respect, Responsibility, Caring, and Honesty).

LICENSED TO SERVE CHILDREN IN KANSAS

KEY Academy programs are licensed by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) and contract with the State of Kansas' Department of Children and Families (DCF).

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

STEP ONE

Visit ymcawichita.org/KEY to learn more about our program and locations. Make sure to review the Parent Policy section for full program enrollment, payment and other important program policies and procedures such as special needs, pick up and drop off and what to bring!

STEP TWO

Complete the online registration forms and permissions for participation. You will need to log into your Y account OR create an account to complete this registration step. This online registration must be complete BEFORE you can proceed with enrollment.

STEP THREE

The school year Enrollment Form can be downloaded online, pulled from the center of this booklet or picked up at a branch. Fill out the form, including selecting your school and sessions. The final step is going to any YMCA branch location to complete your enrollment!

PLEASE REMEMBER

- Online registration forms do NOT hold a space for your child.
- Some locations fill fast and/or have limited availability. Early registration is encouraged.
- Enrollment and payment of fees must be complete, at a YMCA Branch, by Monday a FULL week in advance.

* Complete KDHE Paperwork is required for KEY Academy participation. KDHE paperwork from other/previous Greater Wichita YMCA programs academic years KEY Academy or Summer Camps, etc.) is NOT applicable to satisfy this requirement.



SCHOOL DAY OUT

The Greater Wichita YMCA offers full day School Day Out in select districts and YMCA Branch locations during most school closure days and breaks

KEY Academy participation is not REQUIRED for School Day Out participation. School district-specific registration forms and general enrollment forms for fall, winter, and spring break are available at ymcawichita.org/schooldayout. Pre-registration is required, fees are due at registration and space is limited.

KDHE Paperwork and advanced registration is required for all School Day Out participants and spots are limited so register NOW.
